Take to the ring and have some fun with your canine dance partner.
(Routine is to be a maximum of 2 minutes)

Round Three – Broadway Time....

Choose a popular track from a Broadway or London based Musical and take to the ring. Remember you smile and dazzle

Round Four – Busker Alley

Take to the ring and perform to some music chosen for you by the DJ. Good Luck!

Round Five – Anything Goes

Use what music you would like or routine you would like (please note new KC rules apply for freestyle performing dogs)

Time allowing a “pay on the day” round will follow these rounds.

Toys and food will be allowed in the ring all day.

This is NOT a Show BUT each round will be monitored by an experienced HTM participant.

Dogs must be over 18 months old to perform a freestyle routine & 12 months old to perform a Heelwork to Music routine. This is to be indicated on your entry form.

1. No bitch in season is allowed to take part.
2. Please ensure your dog is fit and healthy to participate.
3. No persons shall carry out punitive correction or harsh handling.
4. No move or handling, which may cause injury to the dog is allowed.
5. All dogs MUST be on lead at all times unless in the Paddock or in or preparing to go in the ring.

There will be a running order on the day. There will be light Refreshments available at this show. No music check in, just hand your CD to the DJ before you enter the ring and collect on exit.
