### **Rounds and order of the day:**

#### **Round One – Winter Warmers**

Use an upbeat piece of music to warm your cockles or use the round to embrace the upcoming seasons..... Is it too early to hear a Christmas track or two!?!?

#### **Round Two – Just getting the hang of it**

For handlers who have competed in less than 5 competitions.  
Take to the ring and have some fun with your canine dance partner.  
(Routine is to be a maximum of 2 minutes)

#### **Feedback round - Take One**

This is a prime opportunity to train your dog in show type environment at one of the best Heelwork to Music venues in the Country. After your routine an experienced HTM judge and/or handler will pass you constructive feedback. Please see below information regarding the running of this class.

#### **Round Three – TV time**

Use a piece of music has been on the TV – be it a show, series or film. Go on be imaginative!

#### **Round Four – Busker Alley**

For a bit of fun: take to the ring and perform to some music chosen for you by the DJ. Good Luck!

## Feedback round - Take two

This is a prime opportunity to train your dog in show type environment at one of the best Heelwork to Music venues in the Country. After your routine an experienced HTM judge and/or handler will pass you constructive feedback. Please see below information regarding the running of this class.

**Time pending there will be a "pay on the day" round after all above rounds are completed.**

**Feedback rounds:** Please note that one feedback judge will give you feedback whilst the other feedback judge will be watching the next round, this keeps the handlers flowing and into the ring consistently.

### **Participation rules:**

1. Dogs do not have to be registered with the Kennel Club to participate, however they must be over 12 months on the day of the show to train HTM and 18 months old in Freestyle.
2. No bitch in season is allowed to participate.
3. Participants are responsible for ensuring that their dog is healthy and fit to participate.
4. No person shall carry out punitive correction or harsh handling in the precincts of the show.
5. No moves or handling which may cause injury to the dog are allowed.
6. All dogs entered must be under control in the precincts of the venue at all times.
7. A handler may only enter for 2 feedback rounds.

### **Show day information**

- There will be a running order and we wish to follow this as closely as possible on the day.
- There will be no music check in, just hand your music to the DJ before you enter the ring and collect on exit.
- Food and toys welcome in the ring.
- When you are not working your dog, we would appreciate it if you remained in the venue as an audience for other participants to simulate a real show atmosphere.
- Dogs will be allowed in the ring during this time to warm up.
- There will be a lunch break when dogs will also be allowed in the ring.
- Please put all poo bags in the black sacks in and near to the paddock.
- All dogs to remain on lead when not in the training ring or in the paddock.
- Dogs can only be walked in the paddock and no where else on the site.
- If you are a smoker please note that you may only smoke by the small silver bin close to the main entrance to the Barn. Please put all cigarette ends in the bin. Thank you.
