



Heelwork to Music Fun Show

Entries on the day, from 9.30am. Judging begins 10.30am

Class 1-4 Entry Fee: £3 per entry (multiple entries per class allowed)

- Class 1** **Just Getting Started** - For dogs and handlers who have never competed, or have competed in Starters, but not been placed 1st to 4th. Toys and Treats allowed in the ring. Routines can contain any combination of Heelwork or Freestyle
- Class 2** **Getting Better** - For dogs and handlers who have won 1st to 4th place in Starters, or who are working at Novice level. No toys or treats allowed in the ring.
- Class 3** **Show Offs** - For dogs and handlers working at intermediate or advanced level. No toys or treats allowed in the ring.
- Class 4** **The Young Ones** Open to dogs under 18 months of age with handler of any age and to handlers under 18 years of age with dog any age. This class may be split. Toys and treats allowed.

Class 5 & 6 Entry Fee: £2 per entry (multiple entries per class allowed)

- Class 5** **Pick your partner** - A novelty class where any number of handlers and dogs can work together. If necessary this class will be split into 2 sections to accommodate beginners and more experienced teams. Toys and treats allowed in the ring.
- Class 6** **Busker Alley** - A novelty class. Handlers and dogs busk to one minute of music (Props will be available). Toys and Treats allowed in the ring.

Class 7 & 8 Training Class Free of Charge (will not be judged)

- Class 7** **Keep the Beat** – Try some fun doggie dressage in this training class. Show the dog moving continuously in time to the music, either walking, trotting or cantering. The routine can be up to 2:30mins. Toys and treats allowed in the ring.
- Class 8** **Dancing Together** – Try some dancing with your dog in this training class. Demonstrate that both you and the dog are dancing incorporating heelwork and freestyle moves on the part of the dog and some moves mirrored by both. The routine can be up to 2:30mins. Toys and treats allowed in the ring.

- a) Routines in all classes can contain Heelwork or freestyle and teams can enter more than once in a class.
- b) Dogs must be over 18 months on the day of the show to compete in Freestyle.
- c) The floor surface is carpet laid on top of rubber matting. The ring size is approx 6metres by 8metres.
- d) Tea, Coffee and Biscuits will be on sale throughout the day. Entrants should bring their own packed lunch.
