ENTRIES CLOSE 15th June. Entries may be taken after that date or on the day at our discretion depending on numbers.

ENTRY FEES & ELIGIBILITY: £4 per entry for YMDTS members and £5 for non-members. 'Pay on the Day' (£6 per entry) may be accepted depending on numbers. Dogs need not be KC registered however they must be over 10 months of age on the day to perform HTM moves and over 16 months for Freestyle moves. Cheques payable to Ynys Môn Dog Training Society.

CLASSES:

1. Kindergarten Heelwork to Music or Freestyle (up to 2.5 mins). For dog and/or handler who have never entered an HTM competition before, the routine can be HW or FS but let us know which on your entry. Toys will be allowed in this class (but no food).
2. Heelwork to Music (up to 3.5 mins). For dogs up to KC Novice equivalent level – a chance to practice your routine in a show environment, try out something new, or simply busk and have fun with your dog.
3. Strictly on Anglesey (up to 3.5 mins). Everyone's opportunity to put their dancing shoes on. Any recognised dance will be accepted e.g. ballet, latin, ballroom, swing, line, hip hop, contemporary, highland.
4. Freestyle (up to 3.5 mins). For dogs up to KC Novice equivalent level – a chance to practice your routine in a show environment, try out something new, or simply busk and have fun with your dog.
5. Elite Class – Heelwork to Music or Freestyle – let us know which on your entry (up to 4 mins). Open to all dogs – a chance to practice your routine in a show environment, try out something new, or simply busk and have fun with your dog.
6. Blind 'Beatles' – (length at DJ discretion) dance to pot luck 'Beatles' music selected by our DJ (toys and food allowed).
7. Pairs Plus (up to 3.5 mins) – any combination of more than 1 handler and 1 dog (toys and food allowed).
8. Anything Goes (up to 3.5 mins) – another chance to work in the ring using toys and food if necessary.

JUDGES: These will be finalised once postal entries are received and notified at the show.

AWARDS: Rosettes to 4th place for classes 1 – 6. Special awards for Classes 7 and 8.

JUDGING: Although normal HTM judging criteria will be the basis for marking in Classes 1, 2, 4 and 5, judges will be encouraged to be flexible in their approach in order to reward elements that they consider should receive special merit such as style, audience appeal, creativity, costume. For classes 3, 6, 7 and 8 judges can set their own marking criteria.

RAFFLE: Please bring along donations for our raffle which will help towards the cost of running the show.

COMPETITION RULES

Running orders will be displayed on the day and we will follow this as closely as possible.

Please bring both outdoor and indoor shoes in case of bad weather. Muddy shoes must not be worn in the barn.

Food must not be taken into the ring at any time except for during classes 6,7 and 8.

Music should be handed to the DJ as you enter the ring. It should be on a CD (tapes are not accepted) and ideally edited to the length required. However we will accept non-edited music providing clear written instructions are handed in with it.

Handlers using harsh handling techniques will be excluded from the competition and may be asked to leave the venue.

Out of control dogs will be excluded from the competition and may be asked to leave the venue.

Dogs fouling in the ring during competition will be eliminated from that round.

Dogs leaving the ring during their routine will be penalised but not eliminated.

Dogs can wear a normal or half check collar with ID tag. Check chains, slip collars, harnesses or head collars are not allowed during practice or competition.

Dogs must be on lead except when competing or practicing.

Handlers must pick up after their dogs, failure to do so may result in being asked to leave the venue.

Bitches in season are not allowed at the venue.

Dogs that have contracted or been knowingly exposed to any infectious or contagious disease during the 21 days prior to the show are not allowed to attend.

Under 16's must be accompanied/supervised by a parent/guardian at all times.

REFRESHMENTS: There will be a catering van on site from 8.30am, please make it worth their while.

Your dog is vulnerable and AT RISK if left in a vehicle in high temperatures and even on days considered as slightly warm. Please take care of your dog. If your dog is found to be at risk forcible entry to your vehicle may be necessary without liability for any damage caused.

DIRECTIONS TO VENUE – Please note that sat. nav. does not work well in the countryside!

A55 ACROSS BRITANNIA BRIDGE TO ANGLESEY, BEFORE END OF BRITANNIA BRIDGE TAKE
LEFT SLIP ROAD, TURN LEFT AT END OF SLIP ROAD (A5),
TAKE NEXT BIG LEFT TURN ONTO A4080 (WHITE TOLL HOUSE ON CORNER),
ABOUT 1½ MILE AFTER BRYNSIENCYN, RIGHT TURN AT B4419 (SIGNED LLANGAFFO, DWYRAN)
TAKE 2ND LEFT (STAGGERED CROSSROADS),
NEXT LEFT AT Y JUNCTION (GAERWEN FARM SIGN) AND LEFT INTO GAERWEN FARM
