

## Canine Freestyle GB Covid 19 Risk Assessment Protocol

The Society will ensure to the best of its ability that the event is run to Covid Safe guidelines. It is your responsibility to ensure you comply with national and local restrictions including advice given about non-essential travel in and out of locally affected regions (which must not be ignored) – in the interests of the safety of all participants this may give rise to a short notice refusal of entry at the Society's discretion. The Kennel Club will respect the Society's exercise of its discretion. If a competitor, or anyone in their household, has Covid-19 related symptoms or has tested positive for Covid-19 they must isolate in line with Government advice – [www.nhs.uk/conditions/coronavirus-covid-19/self-isolation-and-treatment/when-to-self-isolate-and-what-to-do/](http://www.nhs.uk/conditions/coronavirus-covid-19/self-isolation-and-treatment/when-to-self-isolate-and-what-to-do/).

The competitor must not attend the event.

**MUSIC MAY NOT BE CHANGED ON THE DAY, REGARDLESS OF WHETHER IT WAS SUBMITTED IN ADVANCE OF THE COMPETITION OR NOT. MUSIC MUST BE SENT ALONG WITH YOUR ENTRY FORM IN EITHER CD FORMAT OR MEMORY STICK.**

Catalogues must be prepaid and WILL be emailed to you. You will NOT be able to purchase any whilst at the competition.

Checking in will take place in the car park upon your arrival.

Hand sanitising stations will be available and must be used.

There will be a one-way system in place for all competitors entering and exiting the ring.

Anyone within the hall will be required to wear a face mask unless competing in the ring.

Helpers/Stewards will be kept to a minimum and will be required to wear PPE.

The number of people within the venue at any one time will be restricted. Any spectators will be required to bring their own chair, wear a face mask and provide their own hand sanitiser. It is preferable that additional people/spectators do not attend but if they do competitors must provide details of the person, they intend to bring along in order to facilitate Test and Trace.

Judge's tables will be cordoned off with their tables and chairs being cleaned between classes. Judges will also be required to provide their own PPE, stationery and drinks.

Competitors will be required to sanitise their hands, only bring into the hall what they immediately require. Take their own props in and out of the ring or provide their own helper and remove props from the building directly after use. Competitors will need to bring their own seating

Toilets, a queuing system will be in place with restrictions placed on numbers. There will be no loitering to ensure that walkways are kept clear.

Doors will be left open to increase ventilation.

Social distancing is to be maintained whilst queuing for food. No chairs and tables will be provided.

Presentations – Results will be available online and on view outside with any que maintaining social distancing. Trophies/Rosettes/Award Cards will be laid out to be collected by competitors. Judges will not be shaking hands with competitors. Sanitiser will be available.
